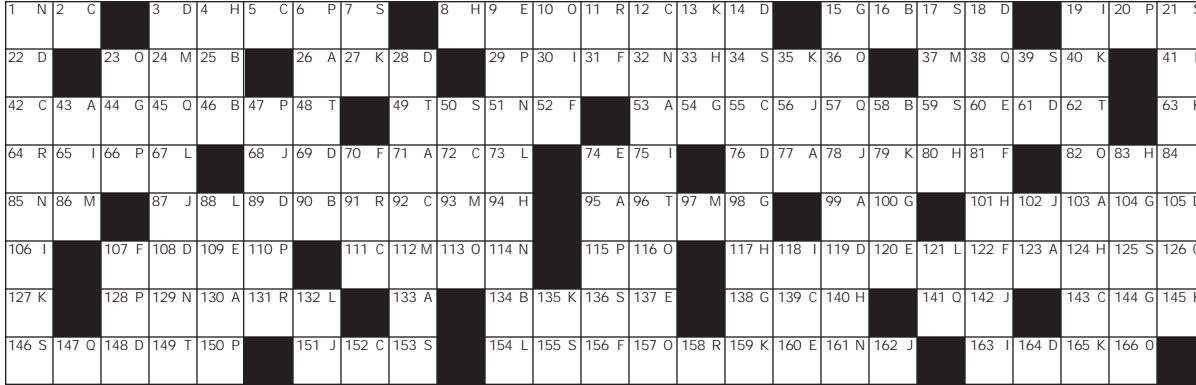


Double Acrostic
