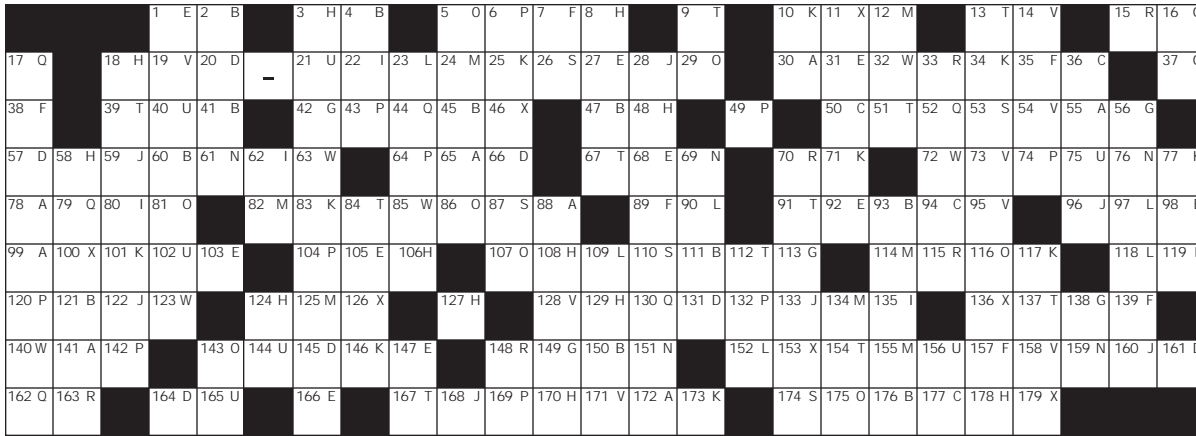


Double Acrostic
