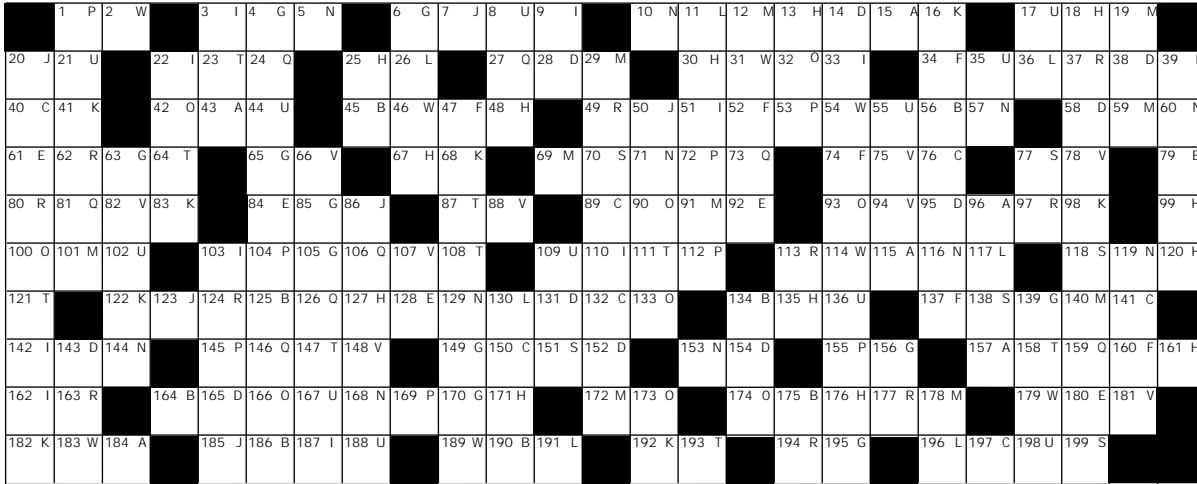


# Double Acrostic
