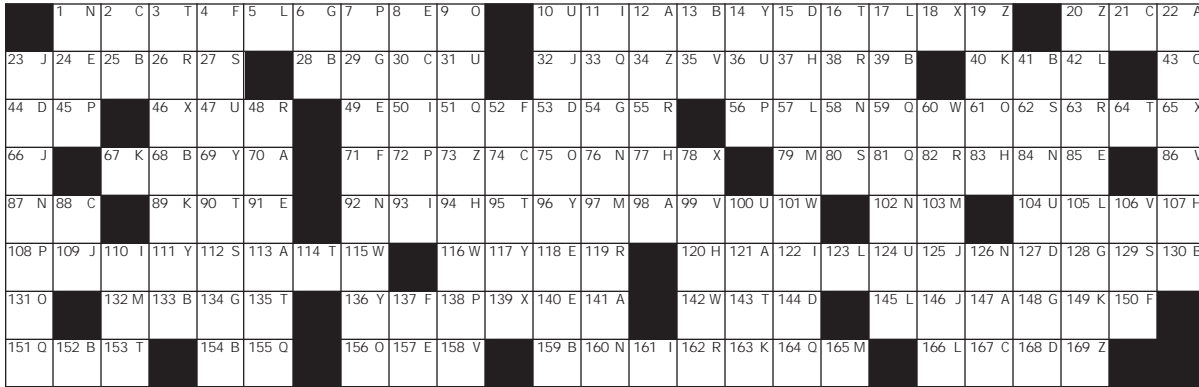


Double Acrostic
