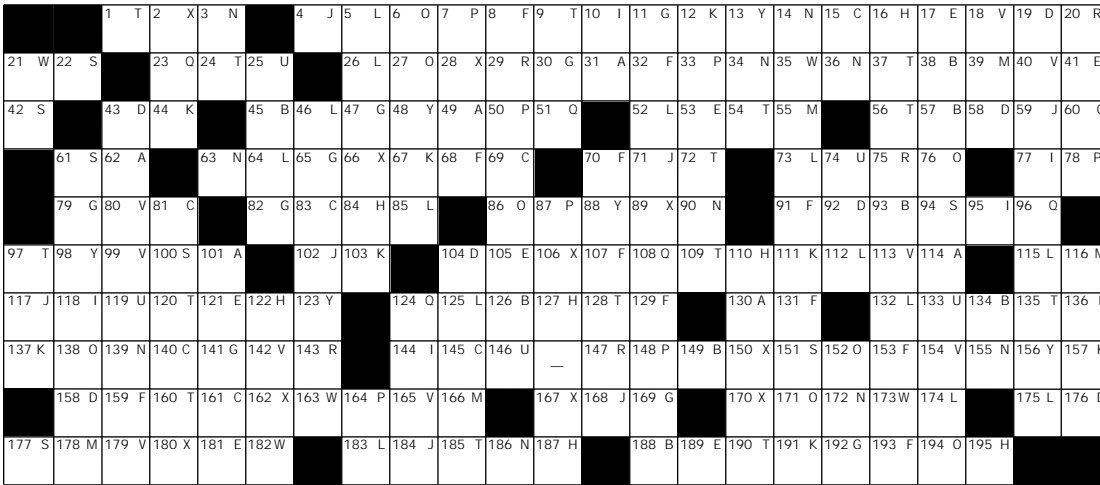


Double Acrostic
